Evidence of Phase Five application

Purpose

Using connectives to write a report about their pet.

Child's voice

'I had to write about my hamster Timmy, he's dead cute!'

Interpretation

My hamster is very naughty because he always wants a chocolate drop. My hamster is cute because he is black and white. My hamster is freakable because he always freaks out. My hamster is horrible because he bites really hard. My hamster is good because he does he not run away. My hamster is a sleepy head because he never gets up. My hamster is called Timmy Fuzzball because I named him.

Application of synthetic phonic knowledge and skills

There are correctly spelt high-frequency words in Adam's writing, for example 'away', 'never' and 'because'. The Phase Five split vowel digraph 'u-e' is correctly shown in the word 'cute' and the 'i-e' in the phonemically plausible attempt of 'white' shown as 'wite'. He also shows an awareness of the alternative 'e' vowel phoneme 'ea' in the word 'head'. Adam does not at this stage correctly apply the 'ed' suffix or the plural 's' in words, for example 'called' is shown as 'calld', 'named' shown as 'namde' and 'bites' shown as 'bitse'.

Evidence of Phase Five and Six application

Purpose

To recount a favourite story.

Child's voice

'Horrid Henry's going on holiday and he doesn't want Peter to come so he has to get a plan, it's funny!'

Interpretation

One day on Monday it was Horrid Henry's holiday because he was going to Australia. Henry was delighted when he heard he was going on holiday to Australia but Peter had to come as well. But Henry had a plan and it was going to be horrid so Henry got his goo shooter and filled Peter's suitcase with 2 kilograms of goo. When they arrived Peter could not wait to put his shorts on. But when Peter opened his suitcase 2 kilograms of goo went in his face.

Application of synthetic phonic knowledge and skills

Adam has knowledge of the alternative Phase Five 'ai' grapheme 'ay' as applied in the words 'holiday' shown as 'holaday' and 'Monday'. The Phase Five tricky word 'could' is also accurately spelt. Adam is applying the 'ing', 'ed', and 'er' suffixes with increased accuracy, as shown in the words 'going', 'filled', 'delighted' shown as 'delited', 'arrived' shown as 'arived', 'opened' and 'shooter'. There is also a phonemically plausible attempt at the polysyllabic word 'kilograms' shown as 'cilergrams'.
